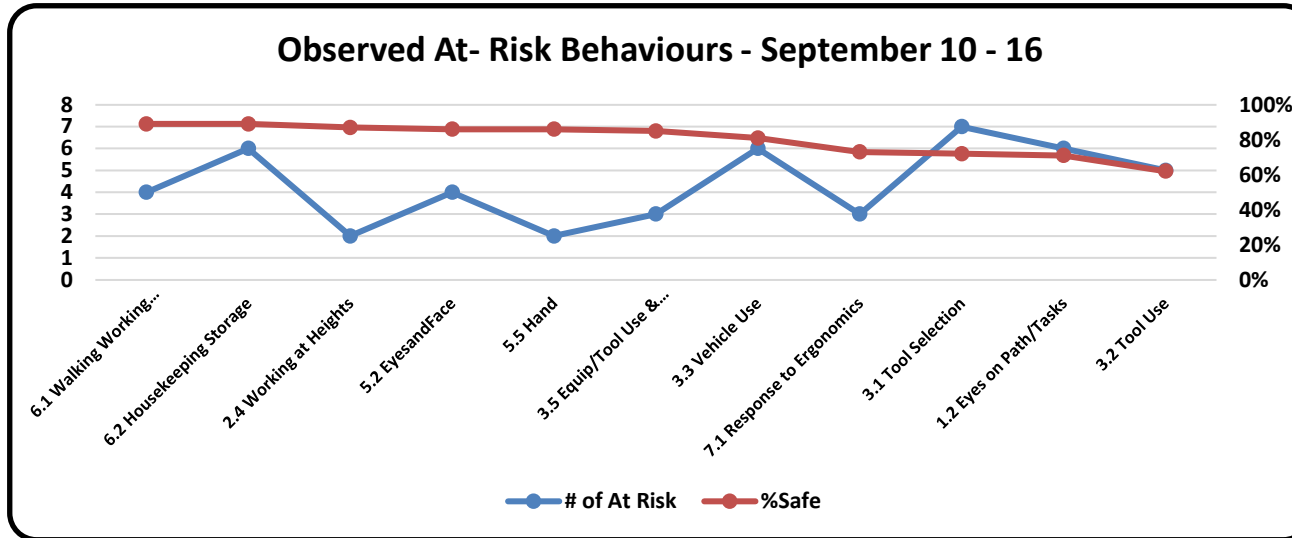

FAC	15-Sept-23	Worker picked up pulley wheel that was hot to touch, burn



STEP UPDATE - TOP 3 AT-RISK BEHAVIOURS:

TOOL SELECTION/USE

- Do you have the right tool for the job? Is it in good working condition? Are safety controls modified? Are you using it properly?

EYES ON PATH/TASKS

- Are you watching where you're at, where you're going, what you're working on **OR** are you looking at papers/electronics/other people as you move about or try to do work?

VEHICLE USE

- Excessive speed, inattention to road signs and signals, idling in units, disrespect for barricades – these driving behaviours are not the way to stay safe on the roadways at work or away!

HOUSEKEEPING/STORAGE

- Things are busy right now!! There's a Turnaround, multiple site projects, and the run and maintain work that keeps us going. With all of the busyness comes tools and equipment. Clean, Organized, and out of the Path of Egress and/or Emergency Response is extremely critical at this time!

The Goal Zero Cup is awarded to a crew or group of workers each shift during the Turnaround.

How Do I Win the Cup?

- Nominations are sent to the STEP Focal.
- Crews are nominated based on **exemplary, visible commitment** to working safely.
 - ⇒Safely completing work in challenging situations.
 - ⇒Mentoring and/or assisting others on safety.
 - ⇒Asking questions to ensure their safety or the safety of others.
 - ⇒Recognizing and working to fix unsafe conditions.
 - ⇒Assisting others who recognize unsafe conditions.

Why Would I Want to Win the Cup?

- It shows you are **Outstanding in the field of Safety**,
- Your name is added to the weekly Safety Prize Draw, and
- Your picture will be in the newsletter holding the cup and the large charity donation cheque (if the prior shift was incident free).
